Liz has worked as an Advanced Case Manager for over 15 years, with adults and children with complex orthopaedic and acquired brain injuries. She balances this with her Medico Legal and private treatment work.

Liz is very experienced in working with children and adults with acquired brain injuries. Liz has experience with the arranging and running of care and therapy packages and supervises large care teams. Liz works with complex care packages that have both private and statutory funding and has experience of Personal Health Budgets.

Liz has a special interest in finding and adapting homes for clients with additional needs and has carried out further training in this area. She has expertise of reading plans and designing accessible bathrooms and kitchens.
